Other bids submitted were: SAK Construction - \$110,307.50; Western Slope Utilities, LLC - \$141,212.50; and C & L Water Solutions, Inc. - \$161,752.50.

In the event that you should fail to execute the Agreement and furnish the Performance and Payment Bonds within the time limit specified, the said Bid Security will be retained as liquidated damages and not as penalty for the delay and extra work caused thereby.
